"Countywide Voting Provides Voting Convenience on Election Day."

Brownsville, TX- Cameron County will be offering countywide voting for the first time on Election Day, November 5th, 2024. Cameron County voters can go to any polling place in the county and they will be able to find and vote their ballot. This year voters do not have to go to a specific precinct location to cast their ballots. The County Elections Department will be deploying a Ballot on Demand system to print their specific ballot that contains all the races they are eligible to vote on. The system is tied to their voter registration records and once they check in, it prints a unique ballot based on where they reside.

Remi Garza, Elections Administrator stated, "Countywide Polling locations and the Ballot on Demand system provides the same convenience of early voting on election day. Qualified voters no longer have to go to a specific polling location to find their ballots. All sixty-eight locations will be able to qualify them and give them their ballot so they can cast their vote on Election Day. This is a big step forward for Cameron County in providing quick and convenient voter access to the polls. This also eliminates the need for voters to find a single location to vote and will prevent voters from ever going to the wrong polling place."

The countywide polling place program differs from the previously used Precinct based system in that voters are no longer restricted to a single polling location on election day. If this program is successful this election and we receive clearance from the Secretary of State, we will be able to continue to use the countywide system in future elections, including local and special elections.
