ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PRIMERA, TEXAS CALLING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY MAY 3, 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON THE MAYOR AND TWO (2) COMMISSIONERS, PLACES 1 AND 4 AND ON THE QUESTION OF THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF PRIMERA AT THE RATE OF ¼ % TO CONTINUE PROVIDING REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS; PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING AND PUBLICATION OF NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF PRIMERA, CAMERON COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code establishes the first Saturday in May as a “uniform election date” for the purpose of conduction general and special elections; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Primera, Texas is the governing body authorized to order a general election pursuant to the Texas Election Code and section 22 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Texas further provide that the Election Code of the State of Texas is applicable to said election, and in establishing the procedures to be followed in said election and in designating the voting places for said election.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PRIMERA, that an election shall be held on May 3, 2025 for the purpose of: VOTING ON THE MAYOR AND TWO (2) COMMISSIONERS, PLACES 1 AND 4; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the ballot shall consist of the following proposition:

FOR the reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Primera at the rate of ¼ % to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

AGAINST the reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Primera at the rate of ¼ % to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the location shall be held at the following place or places in said city:

Early Voting: City of Primera City Hall. 22893 Stuart Place Rd. Primera, Texas.

Tuesday April 22 through Friday April 25 – Time is to be determined by the Cameron County Elections Department.

Saturday April 26 - Time is to be determined by the Cameron County Elections Department.

Sunday April 27 - Time is to be determined by the Cameron County Elections Department.

Monday April 28 through Tuesday April 29 - Time is to be determined by the Cameron County Elections Department.

Election Day: City of Primera Community Center, 16603 Community Drive Primera, Texas parts of precinct 28 and 64. Combes Municipal Complex, 21626 Hand Road, Harlingen, Texas part of precinct 87.

Saturday May 3, 2025 - 7 am to 7 pm

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that early voting by personal appearance shall be held for said election, as provided by the Texas Election Code, upon the order of the Cameron County Commissioners' Court; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that early voting by mail shall be conducted by requesting a mail in ballot from the Election Administrator, 1050 E Madison, Brownsville TX 78520, on or before April 22, 2025, and that said ballots shall be returned to the City Secretary at the same address, on or before May 3, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the City Secretary is hereby authorized and instructed to contract with the Cameron County Elections Administrator for the conduct of the election; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Cameron County Elections Administrator shall be designated as the Early Voting Clerk, the Mail Ballot Clerk and as the custodian of the records of this election;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Cameron County Elections Administrator shall appoint all personnel and officers of the election, and shall include the compensation of said personnel in the expenses of the election; and


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the method of counting prescribed for this election shall be electronic counting; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the mayor shall give notice of this election in accordance with the terms and provisions of Election Code, Section 3.05, that the returns of said election shall be made as provided in the same section, that the mayor shall issue all necessary orders and writs

for said election, and that the returns of said election shall be made available immediately after closing of the polls.


