EVIDENCE OF U.S. CITIZENSHIP

- Long form Certified U.S. Birth Certificate
- Previous U.S. Passport (may be expired, must be undamaged)
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad
- Certificate of Naturalization/Citizenship

PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

- Valid Driver's License (plus a second ID if issued in a different state)
- Undamaged U.S. Passport (if issued less than 15 years ago)
- Certificate of Naturalization
- Valid Government or Military ID

PHOTOGRAPH

- In color, white background, 2 x 2 inches in size and printed on thin, photo-quality paper. Pictures may be taken on site.

CHILDREN

- **Under 16 years old** - Child's Birth Certificate and both parents must be present with photo ID or one parent with a signed, notarized DS-3053 or a signed DS-5525 depending on the circumstances.
- **16 to 17 years old** - Evidence of U.S. Citizenship and one parent must be present with photo ID unless applicant has acceptable photo ID and submits parental awareness.
