## RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, Cameron/Willacy CRTC wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

## HOW TO REPORT

Cameron/Willacy CRTC offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Call our Director, Gene Loya at 956-546-4017.
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or an ill-memo slip.
- Report to the PREA coordinator, Gene Loya or PREA Investigator, Gene Loya/Alfonso Gaucin.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling 956-546-4017.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.

## VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICES
