Both parties to the marriage are required to come into the office to get the actual license; provide identification; and administer oath that information on application is true and correct (Sec. 2.008 of the Texas Family Code) Completing the application before arriving will greatly reduce your time in our public spaces. Customers will need to call and schedule appointment before coming in for their marriage license. These are precautionary measures for the safety of our customers and employees.
