Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Cases

Cameron County has received confirmation of an additional fifteen (15) reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of cases to 254 in Cameron County. Of the 254 cases, 84 individuals have recovered.

Cameron County Public Health continues to investigate the COVID-19 outbreak at the two nursing home facilities. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Veranda Nursing Home has included 21 employees, five (5) individuals related to the employees and 50 residents who have tested positive, including two (2) who have passed away. There have also been 37 employees and 24 residents who have tested negative. The Windsor Atrium currently has 15 employees and 17 residents who have tested positive, including one who has passed away. There has also been one (1) employee and two (2) residents who have tested negative. Individuals at the two facilities who have tested positive continue to be in isolation and employees who have pending results are not working at the facility.

As part of the COVID-19 action response plan, Cameron County Public Health is conducting epidemiological investigations and contact tracing as needed. Cameron County Public Health continues to monitor the situation and will provide updates as they are received.
