INELIGIBILITY TO POSSESS A FIREARM OR AMMUNITION

1. By entry of the Court's Order or Judgement in this case, it has been explained to me to me that I am ineligible under Texas law to possess a firearm or ammunition.
2. Beginning now, if I possess a firearm or ammunition it could lead to charges against me. If I have any questions about how long I remain ineligible to possess a firearm or ammunition, I have been advised to consult an attorney.
3. I understand that under the Texas Penal Code section 46.01(3):
 - a. "Firearm" means any device designed, made, or adapted to expel a projectile through a barrel by using the energy generated by an explosion or burning substance, or any device readily convertible to that use.
 - b. "Firearm" does not include a firearm that may have, as an integral part, a folding knife blade or other characteristics of weapons made illegal by Penal Code Chapter 46 and that is (1) an antique or curio firearm manufactured before 1899 or (2) a replica of an antique or curio firearm manufactured before 1899 but only if the replica does not use rim fire or center fire ammunition.

For more information about the laws that make me ineligible to possess a firearm or ammunition, or for more information on how long I am ineligible to possess a firearm or ammunition lasts, the Court recommends I contact an attorney. For my reference, it has been suggested I consult the statutes listed below, which may or may not apply to my circumstances.
