CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEE TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, April 16, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Sheriff's Office has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. Constituents are asked to continue to conduct business online by going through the County's website at https://www.cameron.county.us/.

"Continue to protect your home from COVID-19. Please follow all CDC recommendations when outside your home to protect those you love. To date, 53% of our County population has been vaccinated with at least one dose.
