**CAMERON COUNTY TO ALLOCATE FIRST-DOSE MODERNA VACCINES TO  
PRIMARY HEALTH CARE DOCTOR'S OFFICES AND PHARMACIES  
AND HOST TWO SECOND-DOSE VACCINATION CLINICS**

This week, Cameron County Public Health will allocate a limited number of first-dose Moderna Vaccines to several primary health care doctor's offices and pharmacies throughout the County. All individuals are encouraged to please contact your primary health care doctor's office or pharmacy and register to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

As a reminder, all homebound / bedridden individuals that are unable to leave their home to receive a vaccine due to medical conditions are encouraged to please contact the Cameron County Office of Emergency Management and Fire Marshal Service at 956-547-7000 to schedule an appointment. Registration call center is available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Cameron County will host a second-dose vaccination clinic tomorrow, April 21, 2021, at the Los Fresnos Fire Department located at 100 Rodeo Dr. for those individuals that were vaccinated with the first-dose of the Moderna Vaccine at the same location on Thursday, March 25, 2021. Individuals are asked to please arrive between 7:00 a.m. through 11:00 a.m., with your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card, and can begin to form line at 6:00 a.m.

A second-dose vaccination clinic in Precinct 4 located at Tony Gonzalez Elementary School, 11142 Military Rd., in Santa Maria will be held on Friday, April 23, 2021, for those individuals that were vaccinated with the first-dose of the Moderna Vaccine at the same location on Friday, March 26, 2021. Clinic will begin at 3:00 p.m. and continue through 5:00 p.m. and individuals are asked to please arrive with your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card.
