CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, April 23, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Sheriff's Office, one (1) employee from the Elections Department, and one (1) employee from the Tax Assessor-Collector's Office have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. Constituents are asked to continue to conduct business online by going through the County's website at https://www.cameron.county.us/.

"To date, 57% of our County population 16 years of age and above has been vaccinated with at least one dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine.
