CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEE TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, May 14, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from Public Health has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.
