CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Today, May 7, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Sheriff's Office, and one (1) employee from the Tax Assessor-Collector's Office have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe. Constituents are asked to continue to conduct business online by going through the County's website at https://www.cameron.county.us/.
