Today, June 18, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Juvenile Probation Department, and two (2) employees from the Sheriff's Office has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.
