The 39 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 41,741 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 62 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 39,303.

Cameron County Public Health does not have any reports of COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents for today. The current total number of COVID-19 deaths is 1,677.

Cameron County continues the vaccination efforts within our communities. As of today, 60.27% of the population 12 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 72.70% has received at least one dose. In addition, 79.04% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 87.64% has received at least one dose.
