**CAMERON COUNTY EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19**

Today, August 13, 2021, the Office of Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr., has been notified that one (1) employee from the Department of Transportation, one (1) employee from Emergency Management, two (2) employees from the International Bridge System, one (1) employee from Parks and Recreation, two (2) employees from the Sheriff's Office, and two (2) employees from the Tax Assessor-Collectors Office have tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, Cameron County will not release specific employee information.

The Public Health Department is working closely with elected officials and department heads to continue taking the appropriate steps to keep their employees and the public safe.
