The 223 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 49,389 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 314 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 44,683.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of thirteen (13) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. These COVID-19 related deaths occurred within the last two weeks. Of these deaths, 11 out of 13 were not vaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,786.

As of today, 74.21% of the population 12 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 89.30% has received at least one dose. In addition, 83.73% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 92.22% has received at least one dose.
