The associate judge's administrative assistant shall serve as administrative assistant for the visiting associate judge and shall continue to perform all his/her regular duties.

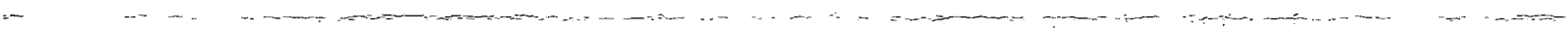
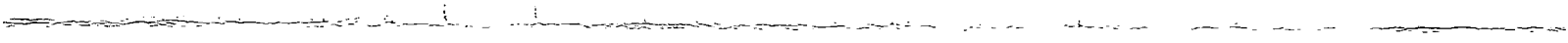

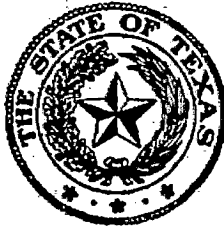
