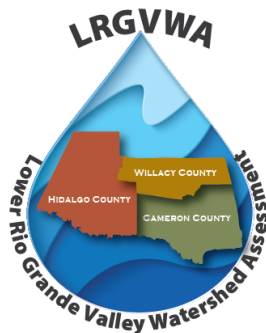

Cameron County and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Galveston District kicked off the Lower Rio Grande Valley Watershed Assessment, a watershed planning study, in 2023 to identify potential projects to address water resource needs in the region. Cameron County and Galveston District personnel will provide attendees with an overview and information on the purpose of a watershed assessment, including the study process, and how to stay involved.

We are seeking input on water resource challenges in the region and opportunities for improvements. We would like to know what concerns and areas you would like to have considered in this study. Input for this project should be within the 4-county area of Cameron, Hidalgo, Kenedy and Willacy Counties relating to flooding, water quality, water supply, economics, and ecosystem restoration.
