ORDER OF ASSIGNMENT





ORDER APPOINTING VISITING ASSOCIATE JUDGE TO CHILD SUPPORT COURT

Pursuant to Section 201.113, Texas Family Code, I appoint the Honorable **Migdalia Lopez** as a visiting judge for Title IV-D cases to perform the duties of the associate judge for the following reason:

The associate judge appointed under Texas Family Code, Chapter 201, Subchapter B is temporarily unable to perform his or her official duties because of absence resulting from family circumstances, illness, injury, disability or military service.

The vising associate judge has served as a master or associate judge under Family Code Chapter 201, a district judge or statutory county court judge for at least two years prior to the date of this assignment.

This assignment is for **December 2 - 3, 2024 (Willacy and Cameron County)** unless shortened or extended by further order of this court; or until another associate judge is appointed to fill the vacancy. This assignment shall continue thereafter so long as may be necessary for the visiting associate judge to complete the trial of any cause begun during the period, and to pass on motions for new trial and all other matters growing out of any cause heard by the visiting associate judge during such period.

The associate judge's administrative assistant shall serve as administrative assistant for the visiting associate judge and shall continue to perform all his/her regular duties.
