(III) CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR THE PREVIOUS SPECIAL MEETING Chairman De Leon asked if there is a motion to approve the minutes for the meeting held on April 21, 2017. (V) CONSIDERATION TO MODIFY CIVIL SERVICE COVERAGE TO EXEMPT CHIEF DEPUTY CONSTABLES IN CONFORMITY WITH COMMISSIONERS' COURT ACTION
