ANNOUNCEMENT OF FUNDS

Pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code, Section 51.961, the County Commissioners Court collects a \$15 family protection fee at the dissolution of every marriage. These funds are deposited in a special "family protection account" and may be dispersed by the Cameron County Commissioners Court to a nonprofit organization that provides family violence and child abuse prevention, intervention, family strengthening, mental health, counseling, legal and marriage preservation service to families that are at risk of experiencing or that have experienced family violence or the abuse or neglect of a child. The nonprofit organizations must be located in Cameron County or in an adjacent county.

OBJECTIVES:

To identify and to disburse funds to those nonprofit organizations located in Cameron County who provide services as stated above.
