Bids will be opened in the Purchasing Department - 3rd Floor, Room # 345 at 10:01 a.m. on deadline date. Bids must include one (1) original of the Bid. Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

1. 330 LF of 48" RCP installed by open cut
2. 2 Concrete Headwalls
3. 500 CY of Channel Excavation

5. Existing Pipe Removal
6. Irrigation Canal Bypass

Checks or Money orders for the bid documents are to be made out to Naismith Engineering, Inc.

A bid bond in the amount of 5% of the bid issued by an acceptable Surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to Cameron County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas General Land Office and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, age, or national origin. Cameron County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by Cameron County for a period not to exceed (sixty) 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidders qualifications prior to the contract award.

All contractors/subcontractors that are debarred, suspended or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project.
