1. Is it possible to obtain a 'General Exception' to all Terms & Conditions with the promise that, if named vendor of choice, we'll work together in good faith to come up with mutually agreeable terms?
A - No, if there are terms that proposer can't agree with, those have to be dealt with after they have been awarded RFP – E
2. The device requirements list on page 48 is blank. This question posed in Addendum #2 question 27 references my question however the answer does not help to clarify why this page is blank. Does the county have any device requirements for RFP 140203?
A - This page is to be completed by the vendors to identify the hardware specifics needed for the vendors' respective EHR system – E *J - I agree, we need to know what hardware the vendor needs for their application to have an idea what needs to be purchased so that the County can make a decision .*
3. Please verify the doctor count. 10 doctors 2 Mid-Levels?
A - The health department currently has 10 physicians and 2 mid-levels which attend to clients within the department – E
4. Are there any plans to add additional doctors in the next 6 to 12 months?
A - It is not our intention to add doctors anytime soon; however, we cannot make any guarantees that it will remain at that same amount – E
5. Can you be more specific regarding the types of alerts you want the EHR system to produce?
A - The alerts can be generalized into two different categories:
 - 1) Alerts within the record: these notify the user of events such as, but not limited to, scheduling conflicts, report reminders, conflicting prescriptions.
 - 2) Alerts to providers: these notify providers of any issues that they need to be aware of such as surveillance alerts which warn about an increase in certain reported conditions. – E



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6. General - What are the interface expectations? What systems will need integration for this project?
A - In order to generate a more productive EHR system, interfacing with agencies such as lab and pharmaceutical services would be beneficial. The systems currently being used are RODS ESSENCE, BioSense, NEDSS, PHIN and ImmTrac – E
