The meeting was called to order by Judge Gilberto Hinojosa. He then asked Mr. Bob Clark, Brownsville resident, for

the invocation and Commissioner Cascos to lead the Court and the audience in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

### (1) APPROVAL OF COUNTY CLAIMS

At this time, Mr. Mark Yates, County Auditor, presented the following late claims as to Warrant No. 11199 in the amount of \$1,200.00, and Warrant Nos. 11203 through 11573, in the amount of \$25,281.50, for approval.
