The meeting was called to order by Judge Pro-tem Pedro "Pete" Benavides at 9:03 A.M.

The Court considered the following matters as posted and filed for Record in the Office of the County Clerk on May 5, 2006 at 3:40 P.M.:

ACTION ITEMS

(1) CONSIDERATION AND AUTHORIZATION TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHANGING THE ROAD NAME OF COUNTY ROAD 745 AKA DUMP ROAD TO PEREIRA COMPASSION ROAD IN BAYVIEW CITRUS GROVE UNIT #2 SUBDIVISION IN PRECINCT NO. 3. (PS-DEPT. OF TRANSPORTATION)

Upon motion by Commissioner Tamayo, seconded by Commissioner Garza and carried unanimously, the public hearing for the purpose of changing the road name of County Road 745 aka Dump Road to Pereira Compassion Road in Bayview Citrus Grove Unit #2 Subdivision in Precinct No. 3 was opened.

Commissioner Garza asked if Road 745 is county approved.

Mr. Richard Walker, Engineering Department, stated that it is a publicly dedicated road and noted that this road is currently not under the County Road System.

Commissioner Garza asked if by changing the name, the road will then be under the County System.

Mr. Walker answered in the negative.

Commissioner Garza noted that one of the continuous problems of this particular road is the County has not been able to go into the road to do work on it because it is not in the County Road System. He added that if we are going to change the names of roads, we should at least consider bringing those roads into the County Road System.

Mr. Walker stated that the road has to meet certain requirements that the County currently has as standards in order for the road to be accepted into the County Road System. He added that the amount of dedication of right-of-way on Road 745 does not meet our requirements and because of that the County cannot bring it into the County System.

Commissioner Tamayo stated that there are several dedicated roads in the County where the issue of the amount of right-of-way arises and agreed with Commissioner Garza in his opinion of bringing the road into the County Road System.

Commissioner Garza added that there is a settlement house at the end of the road and subsequently the road is well-traveled.

Commissioner Tamayo asked if there are any drainage problems on the road and suggested to place it on the agenda to bring the road into the County Road System.

NOTE: Judge Hinojosa joined the meeting at this time.

Mr. Walker noted that the road is scarcely populated, other than the settlement house, and is about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile long.

Upon motion by Commissioner Garza, seconded by Commissioner Tamayo and carried unanimously, the public hearing for the purpose of changing the road name of county road 745 aka Dump Road to Pereira Compassion Road in Bayview Citrus Grove Unit #2 Subdivision in Precinct No. 3 was closed.
