(A) PRESENTATION OF THE AMENDED PRESIDENTIAL PERMIT BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE FOR THE VETERAN'S EXPANSION PROJECT. (PSJ-ADMINISTRATOR)

Ms. Roberta Jacobson, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for North America, Mexico and Canada, presented the Amended Presidential Permit for the Veteran's Expansion Project to Judge Cascos and explained that the Permit authorizes Cameron County to construct, operate, and maintain a two span international bridge, its' approaches, and facilities at the International Boundary between the United States and Mexico.

Judge Cascos commended Mr. Pete Sepulveda, County Administrator, and Mr. David Garcia, Deputy County Administrator, for their hard work regarding this project. He thanked the neighboring city of Matamoros, Mexico for their cooperation and various entities and their representatives that have been involved with the Veteran's Expansion Project since its inception.
